Top Guard has been providing fare services since the HRT's The Tide's founding. We are honored to work for them!



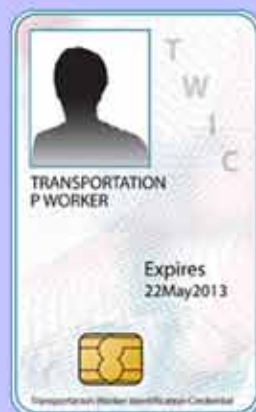
