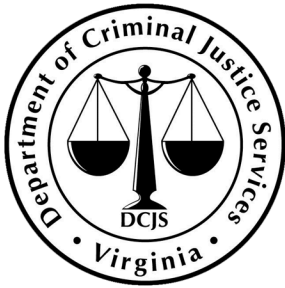
In order to avoid delays in processing, it is important that you submit the correct application and fees. The submission of outdated forms and incorrect fees will result in the applications being returned as incomplete. You can locate the new registration applications at <http://www.dcjs.virginia.gov/licensure-and-regulatory-affairs/forms>

Now that the DMV is issuing photo-identification cards on behalf of DCJS, they no longer have the capability to issue an electronic copy of the registration wallet card. Registrants, who have not yet received their registration through the mail, but need documentation that their registrations have been approved, can obtain documentation by accessing DCJS's online verification system located at <https://www.cms.dcjs.virginia.gov/GLSuiteWeb/Clients/VADCJS/Public/IndividualVerification/Search.aspx>

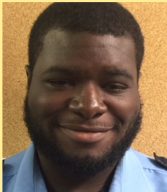
Effective July 1, 2017, DCJS in collaboration with the Virginia DMV began issuing photo-identification cards to Private Security Services Registrants.
